# Preparing to Attend

## STEP 1. REGISTER FOR NATIONAL LEADERSHIP CONFERENCE

Attendees are not registered for the conference until they submit their registration.

## STEP 2. RESERVE HOTEL ROOM(S)

Hotel reservations should be made prior to making travel arrangements to ensure you have confirmed your arrival/departure dates.

## STEP 3. BOOK TRAVEL

After receiving your hotel acknowledgment from the FCCLA Housing Company, travel arrangements should be made.

- ★ All housing is on a first-come, first-served basis
- ★ No pre-blocking for travel agents
- ★ Credit card required to hold rooms

# REAL ID Requirements for Travel

## Important Information for NLC in Orlando

### What is the REAL ID?

A REAL ID is a federally compliant driver's license or identification card that meets increased security standards for domestic air travel.

### Why You Need It:

Starting **May 7, 2025**, all travelers flying within the U.S. will need a REAL ID, passport, or other TSA-accepted ID to board a commercial flight.

### Check Your ID Today!

Look for a **star** in the upper right-hand corner of your Idaho driver's license or ID. That means it's REAL ID compliant.

### If You Don't Have a REAL ID Yet:

- Visit your local DMV to apply.
- Bring required documents (proof of identity, SSN, residency).

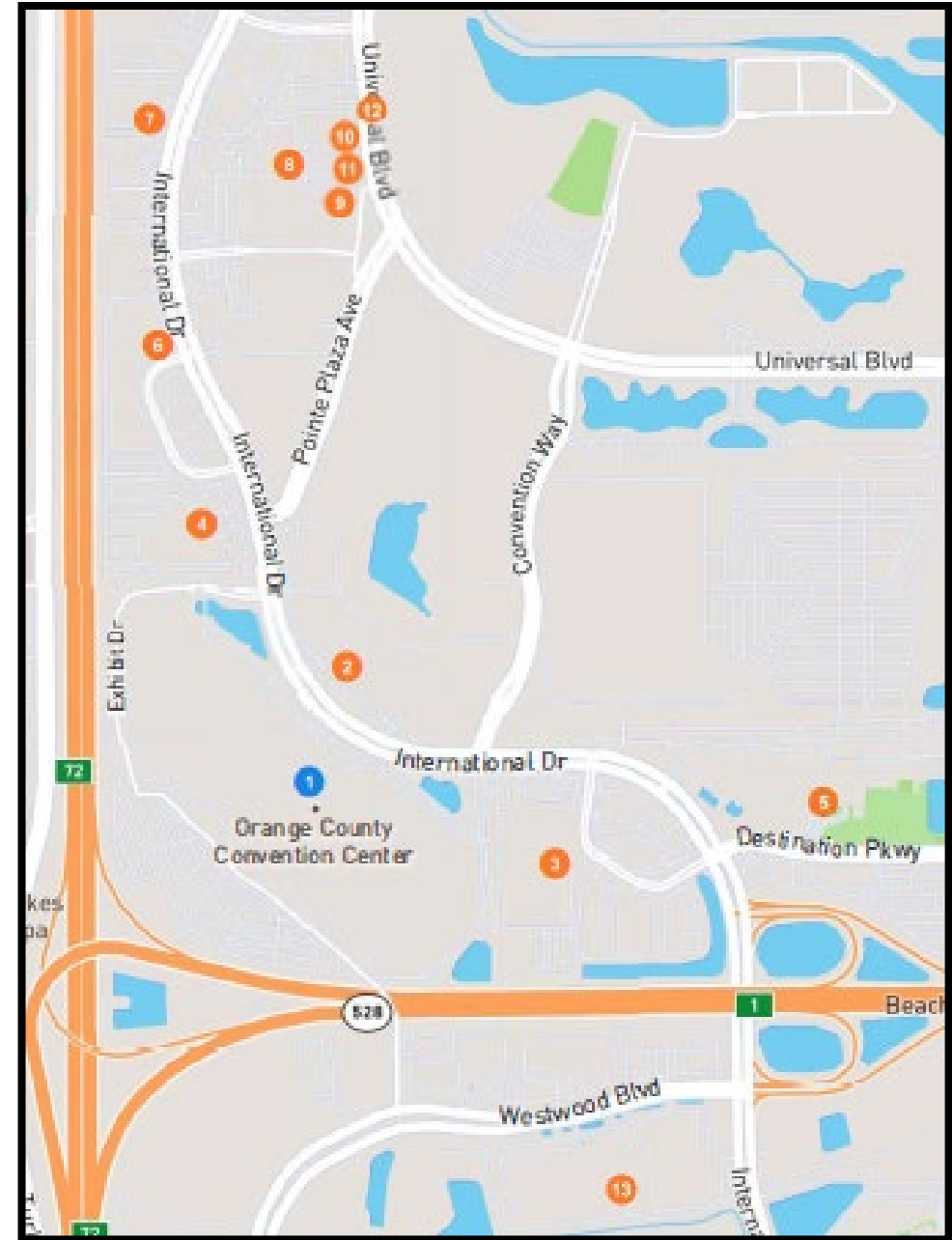

- To be considered tax-exempt you must have a Florida tax-exempt certificate

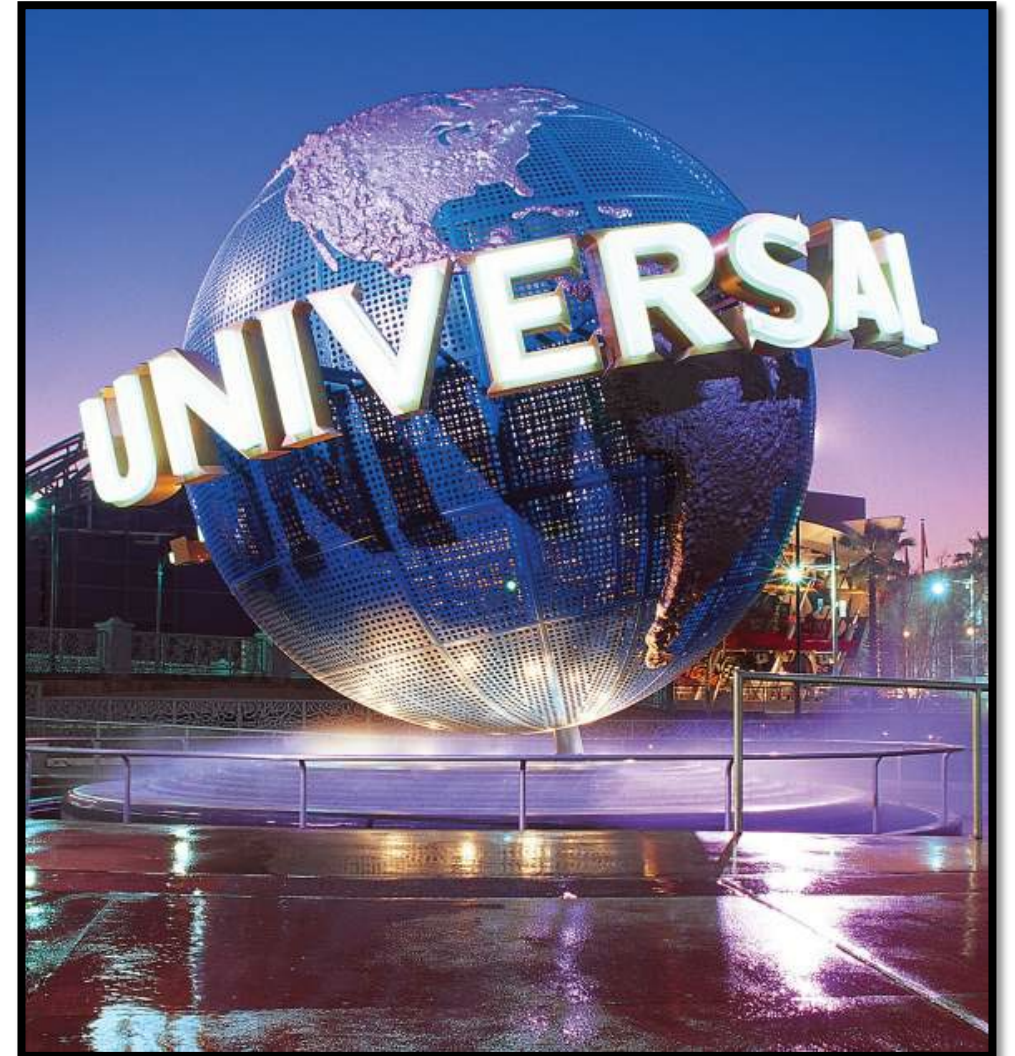
# FCCLA Night at Universal Studios

**Wednesday, July 9, 2025**

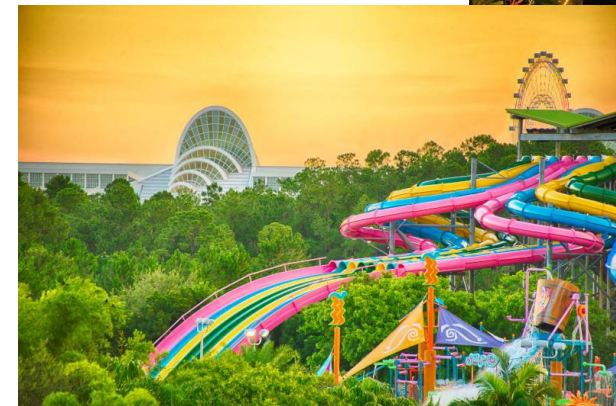
